Course objectives:

The course of academic Czech is intended for foreign students (non-native speakers) of study programmes of UWB taught in Czech who have reached CEFR Level B1+. Students learn not only grammar and vocabulary, but get also acquainted with sociocultural background needed for studying at a Czech university. The course prepares to reach CEFR Level B2.

The UJP/CAU3 course loosely follows the UJP/CAU2 course.

Requirements on student

Credit requirements:

- 1. Attendance is compulsory (2 possible absences).
- 2. Students have to take a midterm test.
- 3. Students have to pass a final test (min. 75 %).
- 4. Students have to submit a portfolio of tasks.
- 5. Students have to give a presentation (8-10 min).

Exam requirements:

The exam is oral and consists of two parts - a monologue on selected topic and a dialogue with the teacher based on the portfolio. The final result is based on the assessment of both parts. The topics are based on the content of the seminars.
