Course objectives:

In the course, students are taught basic Latin grammar and lexicology, focusing on professional communication in healthcare environment. Mastering the basic vocabulary helps the students to describe precisely and in detail anatomical structures and assess pathological health conditions in numerous pre-clinical and clinical specializations.

In the course, students will:

- acquire basic knowledge of Latin - grammatical and lexical.
- understand professional healthcare discourses.
- learn correct pronunciation.
- acquire basic knowledge of Latin and partly Greek medical terminology.
- be oriented in the syntax of elementary texts.
- adopt a logical understanding of the basic vocabulary.
- learn to use a dictionary correctly and efficiently.
- develop logical thinking, linguistic accuracy, feeling for the language and structural insight into the language.
- learn about the culture that formed a basis for the whole learned Europe.

Requirements on student

Credit requirements: active participation in class and completion of progress and credit tests.

Exam requirements: pass written grammar and lexicology test (minimum 75%).

Content

1. Introduction to Latin medical terminology. History of Latin medical terminology. Pronunciation and stress in Latin. Latin nouns - classification. Nouns of 1st declension; Greek nouns belonging to Latin 1st declension; conjugation of the verb esse.
2. Nouns of 2nd declension. Greek nouns belonging to Latin 2nd declension.
3. Adjectives of 1st and 2nd declension. Passive perfect participle.

4. Verbs of 1st- 4th conjugations I. Indicative of present active and passive; imperatives and negative imperatives; conjunctive present active.
5. Nouns of 4th and 5th declension. Overview of anatomical terms.
6. Nouns of 3rd declension - masculines, feminines, neutra.
7. Greek nouns belonging to Latin 3rd declension. Greek word basics. Translation of diagnoses.
8. Progress test. Adjectives of 3rd declension. Active present participle.
9. Adjectives - comparatives and superlatives: regular, irregular, incomplete.
10. Numerals: cardinal, ordinal, multiple.
11. Latin affixation and suffixation. Prescriptions.
