- 8. Security and legislation in education- provide swimming, skiing and other courses, prevention and management of injuries in TV, the responsibility for those entrusted
- 9. The fight against doping-concept, methods, penalties, Czech Republic Anti-Doping Committee, legal documents
- 10. Funding sport- sponsorship, grants, etc., illegal machinations of the sport
